The Board of Trustees is the governing body of the Town of Kiowa, which establishes policy and directs the financial activities of the town. Trustees govern the overall direction of the Town and provide input and resources to the Town operations and events. Participation in a leadership role offers a chance to be a key player in shaping the Town's future and to gain practical leadership experience, along with developing a network of professional contacts.

The Board of Trustees meet each month at 7p.m. at Kiowa Town Hall. To be appointed, you must be a US citizen, resident of Kiowa for at least one year immediately preceding the date of appointment, a registered elector, NOT an employee of the Town, and never convicted of a felony.
