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## **Application for Board Director**

The governing body of the Kiowa Water and Wastewater Authority is the Board of Directors, which establishes policy and directs the financial activities of the Authority. Directors govern the overall direction of the Authority and provide input and resources to the Authority's operations and events. Board Directors are public servants and as such participation in a leadership role offers a chance to be a key player in shaping the Authority's future and to gain practical leadership experience, along with developing a network of professional contacts.

## Qualifications for Kiowa Water and Wastewater Authority Board Membership:

- 1. U.S. Citizen;
- 2. Registered elector of the Town of Kiowa;
- 3. Who owns property that is within the boundaries of the Town; or,
- 4. Who is the natural designated person appointed by the owner of the real property located within the boundaries of the Town which is not a natural person to be qualified to serve on the Board by such owner. Such designation must be in writing and on file with the Secretary of the Board and the Town Clerk. Only one such person may be designated by an owner. The designation by an owner does not require the person to be appointed to the Board;
- 5. Never convicted of a felony; and,
- 6. Not an employee of the Town of Kiowa.

## **Board Trustees are expected to:**

- Board Directors are public servants and as such they should endeavor to align their behavior, actions, and decisions with these principles of good governance. Thus, each Director should adhere to and be committed to a Code of Ethics.
- 2. Have regular attendance at monthly meetings held the second Tuesday of every month at 6pm at Kiowa Town Hall, and all executive and special meetings, scheduled as needed.
- 3. Comply with applicable current state law, concerning conflict of interest and disclosure requirements, including but not limited to C.R.S. 24-18-10 et seq., C.R.S. 31-4-404, C.R.S. 24-18-201, C.R.S.18-4-301, C.R.S. 18-4-401, and C.R.S. 18-8-308.
- 4. Satisfy in good faith your obligations as citizens, including all just financial obligations, especially those such as federal, state, or local taxes that are imposed by law, and all water

and wastewater obligations to the Kiowa Water and Wastewater Authority (KWWA), if applicable.

- 5. Provide input to operations, policies and procedures.
- 6. Promote the Authority to colleagues and community in a positive and respectful manner.
- 7. Board members are responsible for the financial success of the organization.
